Definitions

GDPR GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION ACT

Data Controller Data Controller means the natural or legal person who (either alone or jointly or in common with other persons) determines the purposes for which and the manner in which any personal information are, or are to be, processed.

Data Processor Data Processor means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Data Controller.

Data Subject Data Subject is any living individual who is using our Service and is the subject of Personal Data.

INTRODUCTION

INFORMATION COLLECTION AND USE

We collect several different types of information for various purposes to provide and improve our Service to you.

Types of Data Collected
Personal Data While using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you ("Personal Data"). Personally, identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

USAGE DATA

We may also collect information how the Service is accessed and used ("Usage Data"). TRACKING & COOKIES DATA
